Remembering those affected by the attack from Iran

On March 1st, Beit Shemesh, west of Jerusalem, suffered significant damage due to retaliatory attacks from Iran.

The ballistic missile launched by Iran struck the synagogue in Beit Shemesh, destroying a public air-raid shelter and surrounding homes.

Nine people, including children, lost their lives, and more than 40 were injured. This marks the highest death toll in the current battle, causing widespread anxiety among civilians.

In response to the situation, all schools in Beit Shemesh have decided to close for several weeks.

Children are spending their days at home with their families. Amid the ongoing tense situation, many Israelis are suffering from trauma and PTSD (post-traumatic stress disorder). Children are no exception.

Please remember and pray for the people of Israel, who find themselves once again in the midst of battle after two years of war with the terrorist organization Hamas.
